He also stated that the FAR was in need of increased training for all personnel as well as more material assistance.”</p> | All substantive information redacted. |

Section released in 2004, redacted in 2013: “The outbreak of violence in northeastern Rwanda by the Rwandan Patriotic Front (RPF) threatens ceasefire and ongoing negotiations between the government and the insurgents. If negotiations break down the United Nations could be called to mediate between the two combatants.” | Subject redacted Large portions redacted as “non-responsive” though released in 2004 version. |
