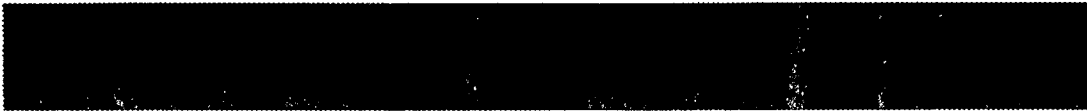

PARTICIPATES IN RALLY. ONE REPORT OF SOLDIERS REFUSING  
TO DEPLOY IN TIAN AN MEN SQUARE. NO TROOP MOVEMENT OR  
INVOLVMENT OBSERVED.

1. ~~(U)~~ AS OF 1600 HOURS LOCAL, 17 MAY 89, THERE HAS  
BEEN NO MILITARY ATTEMPT TO INTERVENE IN THE LARGEST  
STUDENT DEMONSTRATION TO DATE. SIMILARLY, NO TROOP  
MOVEMENTS IN THE CENTRAL BEIJING AREA HAVE BEEN  
OBSERVED IN THE LATEST SERIES OF DEMONSTRATIONS THAT  
BEGAN JUST PRIOR TO GENERAL SECRETARY GORBACHEV'S  
HISTORIC ARRIVAL IN CHINA ON 15 MAY. THE LAST TROOP  
MOVEMENT OBSERVED WAS ONE TRUCK OF SOLDIERS SEEN BY [redacted]  
ON THE ROAD LEADING FROM BEIJING UNIVERSITY TO QINGHUA  
UNIVERSITY AT 0840 HOURS ON 15 MAY. THE TRUCK HAD LPN  
NUMBER B01-1263. [redacted] THE QINGHUA UNIVERSITY  
CAMPUS [redacted] AND NOTED THAT NO TROOPS WERE  
PRESENT ON CAMPUS.

DEMONSTRATORS CONTINUE TO POUR INTO THE AREA FROM ALL DIRECTIONS, WITH SPEEDING AMBULANCES THE ONLY VEHICULAR TRAFFIC PASSING THROUGH THE CROWDS. THE DEMONSTRATORS APPEAR TO BE GENERALLY SUPPORTED BY ONLOOKERS, WHO HAVE OFFERED FOOD, MONEY AND VERBAL ENCOURAGEMENT TO THE MARCHERS.
